## A. Eligibility Documents

## Class A Documents:

- 1. Registration certificate (as applicable):
  - Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)
  - Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for Sole Proprietorship, or
  - Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) for cooperatives, or any proof of such registration.
- 2. Mayor's permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located.
- 3. Statement of all its ongoing and completed government and private (3) three years prior to the deadline for the submission/receipt of bids including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any. The statement shall include, for each contract, the following:
  - a) name of the contract;
  - b) date of the contract;
  - c) kinds of Goods;
  - d) amount of contract and value of outstanding contracts;
  - e) date of delivery; and
  - f) end user's acceptance or official receipt(s) issued for the contract, if completed, with at least 3 Client Satisfactory Services certificates from government and private clients with the same or related projects
- 4. Audited financial statements, stamped "received" by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year, which should not be earlier than two (2) years from bid submission;
- 5. NFCC computation or CLC in accordance with ITB Clause 5.5;
  - NFCC = [(Current assets minus current liabilities) (K)] minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under ongoing contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the contract for this Project.

Where:

K = 10 for a contract duration of one year or less, 15 for a contract duration of more than one year up to two years, and 20 for a contract duration of more than two years.

The CLC must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC
