ANNEX A – ANSWERS TO QUERIES

No.	Query/Comment	Response
1.	Are we allowed to subcontract for this project? If yes, can we use the required certification of our subcontractor (i.e. CMMi)?	<p>For the purpose of the Pre Qualification Stage, subcontractors are not allowed to fulfil the CMM level 3 (or higher) or CMMi level 3 (or higher) organization requirement.</p> <p>The Prospective Bidder itself, or any single Consortium Member with at least ten percent (10%) interest in the Consortium, or any affiliate of the Prospective Bidder or the Consortium Member as described above, should be a CMM level 3 (or higher) or a CMMi level 3 (or higher) organization.</p> <p>Section 12.2.b (<i>Technical Qualification Requirements</i>) of ITPB identifies who may fulfil the requirement:</p> <p>“(b). The Prospective Bidder or a related entity, as described below, should be a CMM level 3 (or higher) or a CMMi level 3 (or higher) organization.</p> <p>The related entity that fulfils this requirement may be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the Prospective Bidder is a partnership or corporation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Prospective Bidder itself; or ii. An Affiliate of the Prospective Bidder (but not a Contractor) • <i>If the Prospective Bidder is a Consortium:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. <u>A single Consortium Member with at least ten percent (10%) interest in the Consortium;</u> or ii. An Affiliate of a Consortium Member with at least ten percent (10%) interest in the Consortium

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		<p>Relevant certificate and information for the same should be attached by the Prospective Bidder in line with the form provided in Annex QD 4.”</p>
2.	<p>Since the system integration is only one-time implementation, can you allow submission of client references with equivalent contract amount of 50 Million instead of 150 Million?</p>	<p>The request is denied. It is clarified that the Client References for the System Integration requirement must include software development & system maintenance and technical helpdesk support. It may also include hardware and server installation, networking support and other related aspects of IT infrastructure project.</p> <p>The software development should have been completed in the last 10 years and the system maintenance and technical helpdesk support should have also been provided for at least three (3) years in the same project. Accordingly, the minimum revenue receipt for each of these two projects should be at least One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (PhP 150,000,000.00) per project, as stated in Section 12.2.c.1 of the ITPB.</p>
3.	<p>The LTFRB project implementation within the period of 10 years is more of the infrastructure which have the higher value because of its components such as hardware, third party licenses, network, security, bandwidth, manpower, maintenance and support. We suggest that the Bidder’s track record should have at least 150 Million project.</p>	<p>The request is denied.</p> <p>It is further clarified that the System Integration experience requirement covers the aspect of long term project implementation.</p> <p>Further, the same projects cited as System Integration experience may also satisfy the Hardware Products Installation experience with a revenue received on account of installation of servers and networking equipment should be atleast PhP 50,000,000.00 each as required in Section 12.2.c.2 (<i>Technical Qualification Requirements</i>) of ITPB.</p> <p>In such a case, the same project</p>

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		experiences may be claimed by the Prospective Bidder in this category as well, subject to meeting all criteria specified in ITPB.
4.	<p>Should each of the two (2) projects have a minimum contract amount of Php 150,000,000? Total of Php300,000,000? Or should there just be at least one (1) with minimum contract amount of Php 150,000,000, and the other project can be of any amount?</p> <p>Proposed Redraft:</p> <p>Proposal is for the potential bidder to provide at least two (2) projects, with atleast one (1) of the projects having a minimum contract amount of Php 150,000,000</p>	<p>The request is denied. The minimum revenue receipt, not the contract amount, for each of these two projects should be at least One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (PhP 150,000,000.00) per project. Kindly refer to Section 12.2.c.1 (<i>Technical Qualification Requirements</i>) of ITPB for further detail.</p>
