# Innovative Financing for Sustainable Development





- Canada is establishing new innovative partnerships that catalyze private sector investment and generate more opportunities for the poorest and most vulnerable to benefit from economic growth;
- Canada believes that development financing has been proven to be more inclusive and sustainable when it promotes gender equality and empowers girls and women;
- Canada's development finance institution, FinDev Canada, demonstrates Canada's support for innovative financing for international development







# Climate Finance





## Growing Climate Finance Flows

- Global commitment to mobilize US\$100 Billion a year by 2020;
- Canada is currently delivering on its pledge to provide CAD \$2.65 billion in climate finance;
- Collectively, the MDBs committed US\$43, 101 Million in climate finance in 2018;





## Canadian Climate Fund for the Private Sector in Asia II (CFPS II)

- USD 150 Million, established in 2017;
- ADB-managed trust fund to support private sector climate change and gender equality in developing Asia and the Pacific;
- Offers concessional cofinancing for projects that would not proceed solely on a commercial basis;
- Financial modalities: project finance, corporate finance, PPP, financial institutions.

- Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka

### Central and West Asia

- Armenia, Georgia, Kyrgyz Republic, Mongolia, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan

### Southeast Asia

- Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Philippines, Timor-Leste, Viet Nam

### Pacific/Oceania

- Fiji, Kiribati, Maldives, Marshall Islands, Federated State of Micronesia, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu
