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INVITATION TO SUBMIT COMPARATIVE PROPOSALS

for the Quezon City No Contact Apprehension Program

The Quezon City Government (“City”), through its Public-Private Partnership Selection Committee (“PPP-SC”), invites Challengers to submit Comparative Proposals to enter into a contractual joint venture (“JV”) to undertake the development, installation, operation, and maintenance of the Quezon City No Contact Apprehension Program (“QC-NCAP”, or the “Project”). The Project aims to establish a road rules enforcement program that will use the latest and most widely used and accepted traffic enforcement cameras, software and tools that will help the City implement its traffic alleviation program by efficiently enforcing traffic road rules by using industry accepted technologies thus, making Quezon City’s roads safer and accessible for pedestrians and motorists.

On 15 November 2019, the City granted Original Proponent Status to Qpax Traffic Systems (“Original Proponent”) for its unsolicited proposal for the Project. The Project will be awarded in accordance with the Competitive Challenge Process under Section 27(B)(3) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (“IRR”) of the Quezon City PPP Code (Ordinance No. SP-2336, s.2014). Challengers shall be evaluated on whether they are able to:

1. present equal or better qualifications than the Original Proponent;
2. submit a Technical Proposal that complies with the Minimum Performance Standards and Specifications (“MPSS”) for the Project; and
3. submit a Financial Proposal that is superior to the proposal of the Original Proponent.

If a Superior Challenger is identified, the Original Proponent shall be given the opportunity to exercise its right-to-match by submitting a matching offer to the City. If the City does not receive a valid matching offer from the Original Proponent, the Superior Challenger will be awarded the Project. If no qualified Comparative Proposal is submitted to the City within the prescribed period, the Project shall be awarded to the Original Proponent in accordance with the Quezon City PPP Code.

Starting 22 July 2020, interested challengers may obtain the Tender Documents consisting of: (1) the Instructions to Challengers and its annexes, and (2) the draft Joint Venture Agreement and its annexes including the draft Minimum Performance Standards & Specifications, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Twenty Five Thousand Pesos

(P25,000.00). The fee may be paid in cash or by Manager's Check issued by a reputable bank in the Philippines payable to the Quezon City Local Government. Only Comparative Proposals from Challengers that purchased the Tender Documents shall be accepted by the City. Challengers must submit their Comparative Proposals within sixty (60) working days from 22 July 2020.

The City reserves the right to accept or reject any Comparative Proposal, or annul the Competitive Challenge Process, at its discretion. Challengers shall bear all costs associated with their participation in the Competitive Challenge Process, including but not limited to the preparation and submission of Comparative Proposals, and all possible losses or damages directly or indirectly arising therefrom. The City shall not be held responsible or liable in any way for such costs, losses, or damages.
